I. **1:05 Meeting called to order by David Kominz**

II. **1:20 pm : 43 Coburn Rd – Title 5 Variance to property line**

Jason Lavoie, P.E. from The Jillson Company came to the meeting to give the BOH members information on this property. This is an existing 5BR home that was recently purchased and the new owners want to do an addition to the home. The cesspool for the house is in failure, and a new septic system needs to be installed. The Jillson Company did soil testing on the property, and the only spot they could find with parent material was next to the property line of the abutting property. They are proposing a Drip Irrigation Perc Rite System to be designed for 5BR's without a garbage grinder, 6.5 feet from the property line.

Dr. Kominz asked the engineer if they would have back up power if they lost electricity. The owners will have a generator installed. The Board voted to grant this variance for the reduction of the septic system from 10 ft. required to 6.5 ft. from the abutter's property line.

Jason Lavoie of the Jillson Company will send in a full submission to the BOH for approval.

IV. **Director's Report**

- Dr. David Kominz asked Ms. Diotalevi about the status of Case Estates. Ms. Diotalevi is in the process of getting the quotes and design construction information from several engineers. The size of the plant was proposed to be for 50,000 gallons. The site already has the usage of about 23,000 gallons. This would allow for needed expansion. The size of the proposed building for the treatment plant is about 50x30 feet. The engineers are supposed to have bids in by the end of February for this feasibility study. They would like to be able to put the cost (around \$15,000) in for the Town Meeting in May.
- WERC/Emergency Preparedness: Ms. Diotalevi spoke about the upcoming events for WERC this year. They will be doing Spring Fling, Homeowners Workshop and MYCHIP Program.
- Wellness Committee: Ms. Diotalevi spoke about this group and Jane Brown, R.N. is updating our information for them.
- Narcan Training: Dr. DiPietro asked if the BOH members and office staff could be trained on the use of Narcan in case of public health emergencies. Ms. Diotalevi will speak to the Police Chief to see if they can do the training.
