Chapter 107 of the Acts of 2022, “An Act Relative to Extending Certain State of Emergency Accommodations”, authorizes municipal boards to hold fully remote or hybrid meetings through March of 2023. The law does not mandate or prohibit in-person meetings; instead, it allows the Town flexibility in that regard. 310CMR15.211(1) of the MassDEP Environmental Code Title 5 – Minimum Setback Distances

- Septic Tank and Soil Absorption System Offset to Wetlands Bordering Surface Water Supply or Tributary thereto

Town of Weston Board of Health Regulations:

- 2.5 Distance Requirements. * No part of the structural components of a leaching facility shall be located within 100 feet of a wetland as defined in M.G.L. chapter 131 section 40 (Wetland Protection Act).

310CMR15.211(1) of the MassDEP Environmental Code Title 5 – Minimum Setback Distances

- Request reduction in the offset from a building foundation from 20 feet to 10 feet.
- Request reduction in the offset from a property bound from 10 feet to 7 feet.
- Request reduction in the offset from a tributary stream to a surface water supply from 200 feet to 127 feet.
- Request reduction in the offset from a wetland bordering a surface water supply or tributary thereto from 100 feet to 94.5 feet.

Town of Weston Board of Health Regulations Section 2.5 of Chapter VI

- Request reduction in the offset from nearby wetland from 100 feet to 94.5 feet.
- Request reduction in the offset from the building foundation from 20 feet to 10 feet.

- To use Zoom with video on a smart phone or tablet you must download the Zoom app first. After you've downloaded the app, enter the Zoom Meeting ID.
- To use Zoom on a computer, you have to download an installer the first time you join a meeting, which you'll automatically be asked to do. After that, you'll join meetings automatically when you click on the meeting link.
