Approve a request from the Council on Aging to accept a donation of \$100 from Barbara and Peter Casey and a block grant of \$16,000 from the Friends of the Council on Aging, both to be applied to the Miscellaneous Gift Account.

Approve a request from the Weston Police Department to accept a gift of \$2,500 from Mr. and Mrs. Josef J.D. Gazzola to be applied to the Josephine Gazzola Advancing and Supporting Women in Law Enforcement fund.

Approve a request from the Weston Public Library to accept the distribution of \$8,500 from the Nathalie and Theodore Jones Charitable Trust to be applied to the Library General Purposes Fund.

Authorize Town Manager to Sign the Regional Housing Services Office Agreement for 2021-2022.

Update Weston Service Program Policy to increase the hourly rate to match the Massachusetts minimum wage of \$13.50 per hour.

Renew Fire Chief and Forest Warden David Soar's contract effective February 11, 2020 to February 10, 2023.

Lift the muzzle order placed on Layla, the golden retriever belonging to Kelley Murphy. Layla successfully completed training from a certified dog trainer and Animal Control Officer Karen O'Reilly recommends this relief; however, the mandatory leash order remains in effect permanently for whenever the dog is not on the owner's property.

- All participants will be on mute upon entering the meeting. Please keep yourself on mute
- The public is asked not to speak until the Chair asks for public questions/comments. Anyone who speaks over any member of the Board will be automatically muted
- To be recognized, click on the "Reactions" button on the lower (or upper) bar and activate the 'Raise Hand' icon. You will be placed in a queue and called upon in order.
- For participants calling in on a phone, press *9 to raise the hand icon
- The chat function has been disabled
- Participants do not have the ability to change their name while in the meeting
- Anyone who is seen holding up signs will have their video disconnected
- Anyone who is seen making rude or disruptive gestures will have their video disconnected
- Members of the audience who cannot conduct themselves in a civil manner will be placed in the waiting room for a period of time
