**I. Approval of March 2, 2021, March 16, 2021 and April 13, 2021 Minutes** – Dr. Elisabeth DiPietro moved to approve all minutes, Dr. David Kominz 2<sup>nd</sup> - Approved with 1 revision – to April 13 minutes – changes completed.

**II. Hearing for Solid Waste Regulations** – Public Health Director Wendy Diotalevi sent the board members a document that Laurie Bent and Julia Greene thought should be added to the BOH new regulations to enhance the Mandatory Recycling Section of these new Solid Waste regulations to be adopted. *The board members discussed additional description of recyclables that Julia Greene sent.* Unfortunately, there were technical issues with Julia Greene’s email that delayed the information to the BOH for incorporation into the Private Hauler regulations. Additionally, Julia Greene’s suggestions are not yet on the Mass DEP template for private hauler regulations. Though the additional information was interesting it was decided that a more thorough discussion could be done at a later date, after addition to Mass DEP Private Hauler regulations on the state website and could be added to the private hauler regulations for Weston in the future as an addendum. Dr. DiPietro felt that a delay in adopting the private hauler regulations to incorporate this information may result in the regulations not being adopted at all this year. Dr. Elisabeth DiPietro motioned to adopt the Solid Waste Recyclable Regulation for Weston and Dr. David Kominz second the motion and was passed as they were written for April 27, 2021. Laura Azzam spoke about the Solid Waste regulations to be posted on the Town Website for residents to get information and abide by the new regulations that will start on July 1, 2021. There will also be educational materials posted on the website.

The Bulky Waste program will begin on Saturday May 1<sup>st</sup> at the Transfer Station in Weston.

Public Health Director, Wendy Diotalevi posted the regulations in the newspapers on Wednesday April 28<sup>th</sup>.

**III COVID Vaccine Update**– Wendy Diotalevi, spoke about the last 2 clinics to be held for COVID shots on April 30<sup>th</sup> and May 7<sup>th</sup>.

The Board of Health did a total of 13 homebound residents.

Laura Azzam spoke about Regis College doing clinics for their students and staff.

Wendy Diotalevi spoke about all of the upcoming events for the school year and summer programs in Weston. The team is working on getting them looked at and approved as they come in.

Wendy spoke about the 10 positive cases at this time with 7 contacts. Still no Community spread
