**Michael Tabak** studied for ten years at the Juilliard School of Music Preparatory Division where he was rated “Exceptional” by the woodwind faculty jury and was soloist multiple times with the orchestra. He has been principal flute of many orchestras, and currently is principal flute of the [Apollo Ensemble of Boston](#). He is a founding member of The Weston Wind Quintet and The Aujourd’hui Ensemble. **Corinne Foley** attends the New England Conservatory where she studies with John Ferrillo (principal oboe of the Boston Symphony) and Anne Marie Gabriele (an oboist with the Los Angeles Philharmonic). Corinne previously studied with Jamie Roberts (assistant principal oboe of the National Symphony Orchestra).

**Danby Cho** holds a Doctor of Musical Arts degree from Boston University and is a member of the national music honor society Pi Kappa Lambda. She has been a soloist with orchestras here and abroad and has been principal clarinet with the Boston Chamber Symphony. She has been a prize winner in solo and chamber music competitions and has taught clarinet in Boston and at Tanglewood. She joined The Weston Wind Quintet in 2011 and is a founding member of Trio Mirabile.

**Elizabeth Jones** earned her Master of Music degree from Illinois State University, where she performed with the Faculty Brass Quintet and received the Exceptional Merit in the Arts award. She has played with the Claflin Hill Symphony, Atlantic Symphony, Reagle Music Theater, Worcester Chorus, and others. Libby has played with The Weston Wind Quintet since 2014 and became a core member in 2018. She also teaches private lessons on the South Shore.

**Shu Satoh** has been principal bassoon of many orchestras including the Merrimack Valley Philharmonic, Newton Symphony, Boston Civic, New Philharmonia (in Newton), and (currently) [The Apollo Ensemble of Boston](#). He is a founding member of the Windhammer Chamber Players and a member of the Aujourd’hui Ensemble. Shu has been a member of The Weston Wind Quintet since 2011.
