Engineering Division:

- 1) Pond Brook Circle Drainage Project ongoing – Final landscaping taking place this next couple of weeks;
- 2) Black Oak Pump Station Project ongoing – Landscaping and screening work still remain.
- 3) Solar PV Project – Replacement of recycling trailers to original locations;
- 4) Old Colony Road Water Main Project (FY16) – Laid out temporary water main;
- 5) Overseeing consultants' work on several sidewalk feasibility studies (Merriam Street, Highland Street, and Warren Avenue) – Feasibility plans available for viewing on-line. Outreach by Committee conducted;
- 6) Overseeing consultant's work on the modification of the Boston Post Road / Wellesley Street intersection study and the Boston Post Road / School Street intersection study;
- 7) Consultant preparing alternative analysis for railing along Church Street at retaining wall ongoing;
- 8) Finalizing consultant proposal and scope for the Paines Hill Water Tank Improvement Project;
- 9) Brown Street Sidewalk Project advertised. Project bids opened on April 7, 2016. Evaluating award;
- 10) Route 30 (South Avenue) and Wellesley Street Signal Improvement Project contract awarded. Construction activities started;
- 11) Overseeing consultant design work for drainage work for construction season 2016 (Newton Street);
- 12) Overseeing National Grid's gas relay project on Boston Post Road (Linwood to Church Street);
- 13) North Avenue Roadway Resurfacing Work – Preparation work has begun including curbing work at the intersection of Church Street;
- 14) Wellesley Street Roadway Resurfacing Work – Anticipated to begin mill and overlay work middle of June.
- 15) Currently reviewing 11 Stormwater Permits;
- 16) Currently issued 52 Stormwater permits which also requires construction inspection.



Our Parks and Cemeteries Supervisor made a new friend last week.

Water Division:

- 1) Completed approximately 65 DigSafes;
- 2) Performed weekly water samples (4) and station/tank inspections;
- 3) Conducted 6 final meter reads;
- 4) Oversaw the installation of a new fire hydrant;
- 5) Inspected 1 repair of leaking water service;

- 6) Continue water meter reading cycle 1;
- 7) Completed hydrant flushing program.

Park and Cemetery Division:

- 1) Officiated 2 funeral services;
- 2) Mowed and trimmed approximately 15 acres of cemetery land;
- 3) Mowed and trimmed approximately 5 acres of park land;
- 4) Mowed and trimmed Town Center;

Solid Waste and Recycling Division:

- 1) Processed approximately 25 tons of solid waste and 16 tons of recycling;
- 2) Policed Transfer Station for litter;
- 3) Picked up trash and recycling at various town buildings;
- 4) Ongoing Voluntary Pilot PAYT Program.

Highway/Stormwater Divisions:

- 1) Swept roadways around Town Center and cleaned sidewalks for graduation ceremonies;
- 2) Preparation work for roadway work on North Avenue;
- 3) Removed old post and rail fence and replaced with new post and rails;

Vehicle Maintenance Division:

- 1) Performed routine maintenance (fluid services, tires and brakes, exhaust, steering and suspension, exterior trim work and electrical repairs) on 15 school buses, 7 police vehicles, 3 DPW trucks and other equipment, 0 recreation vehicle, and 0 school grounds vehicle;
- 2) Performed 1 major repairs on Bus No. 19 at dealer for EGR cooler;
- 3) Performed 2 repairs on sanders/plows (A-2 and M-1).
